

- 1. DNA evidence points to human origins beginning in Africa, and that humanity migrated out of Africa to the other parts of the planet over time. When did humans leave Africa, when did they arrive in North America and how long did this migration take?
- 2. What are the two broad categories that describe the factors that drive human migration and provide two examples for each category.
- 3. Two primary sources of evidence were mentioned during this lesson, identify them and explain how they demonstrate human habitation of North America.
- 4. What are the two main theories used by scientists, historians and anthropologists to explain how humans arrived in North America?
- 5. Cause and effect is a useful tool for understanding past events. Fill in the Cause-and-Effect template provided, identifying two causes and two consequences of human migration to North America.
