## Introduction:

## Assignment:

Choose one of the five characteristics of Canada and answer the following questions:

- 1. Why is it important?
- 2. What is it that makes / made it possible?
- 3. Is there something that we need to do in order to maintain them? Are they in danger of being lost?
- 4. Is there something that protects them?
- 5. In a brief paragraph, explain what you believe the consequences would be if we were to lose your chosen Canadian characteristic. Would Canada be a better place? Would we be less of a nation if we lost it? Would its loss benefit or harm the people? In what way?

## Rubric:

Q1: four points (provides a clear explanation as to why it is important to Canada)

Q2 – 4: two points each (identifies the relevant information / item)

Q5: 10 points – (clearly identifies the ways in which Canada would be affected by the loss of this characteristic – explains how it is either beneficial or harmful to Canada as a nation, as well as the citizens of Canada)
